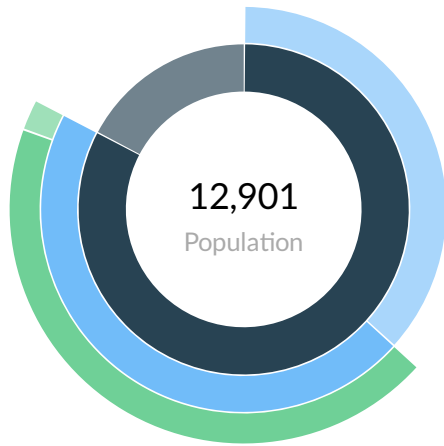
Median household income is \$14.2K below the national median household income of \$60.3K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population declined by 3.3% since 2015, falling by 444. Population is expected to decrease by 2.4% between 2020 and 2025, losing 307.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 3.2% in Greene County, IL from 2,783 to 2,871. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 0.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 55.1% to 55.6% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, 8.6% of Greene County, IL residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (11.4% below the national average), and 8.8% hold an Associate's Degree (0.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Specialty (except Psychiatric and Substance Abuse) Hospitals.

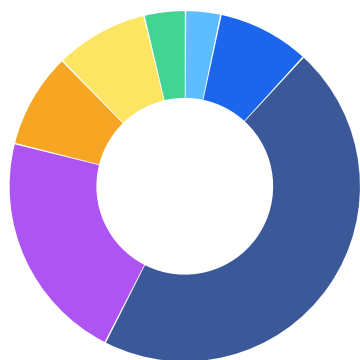

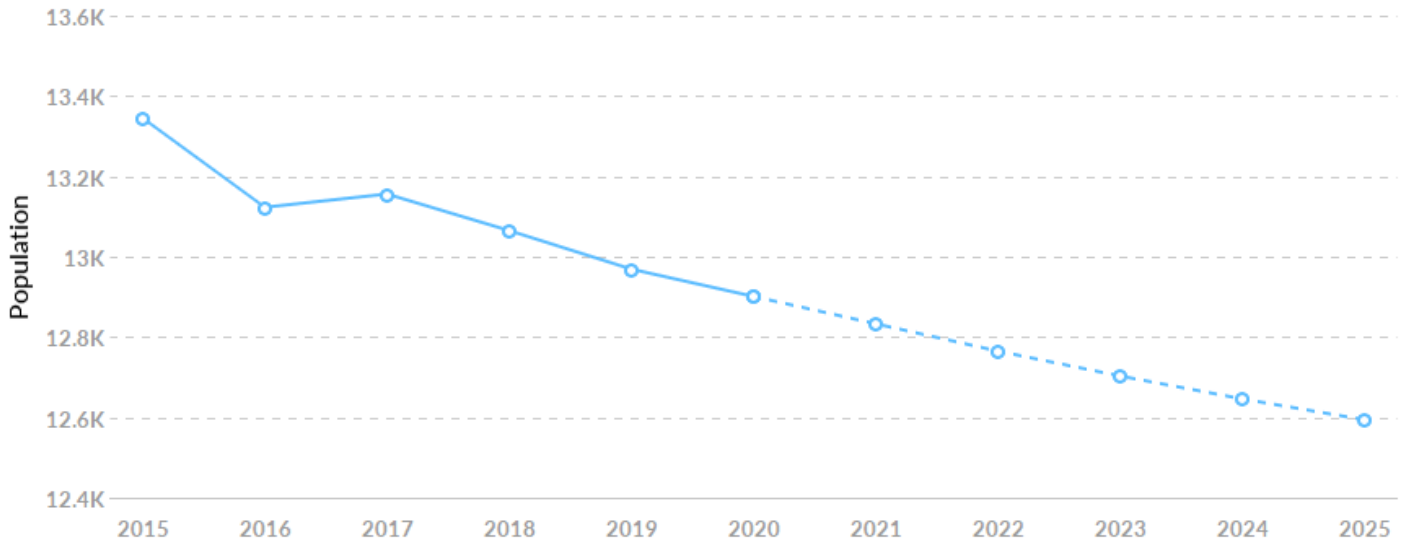

Population Trends

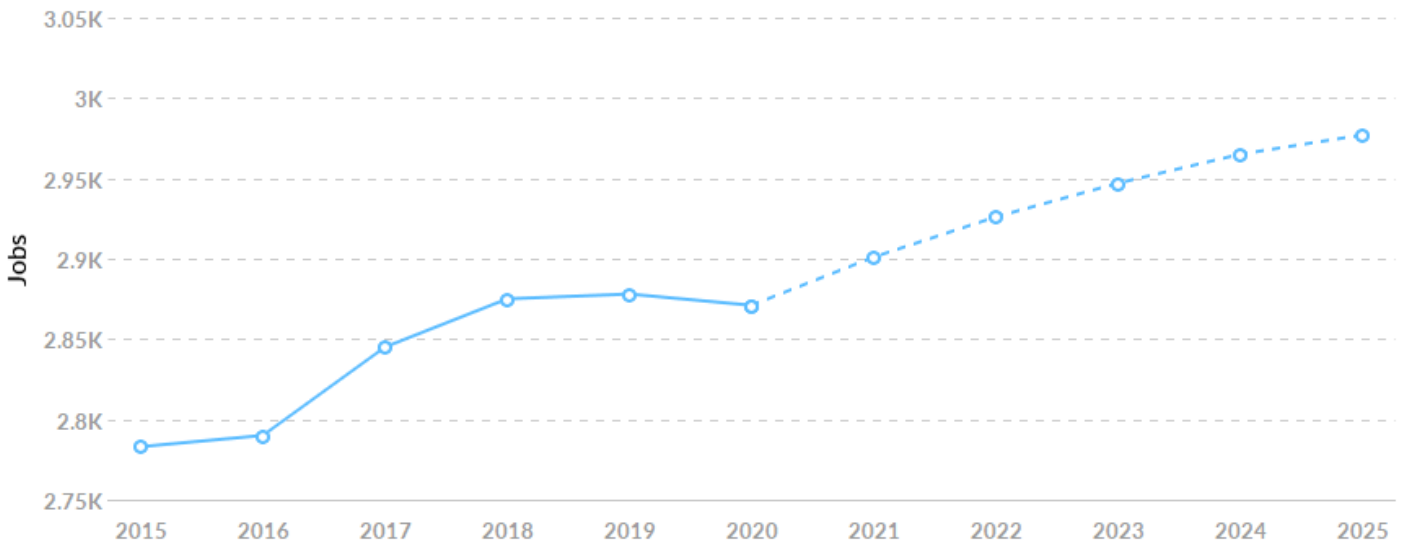

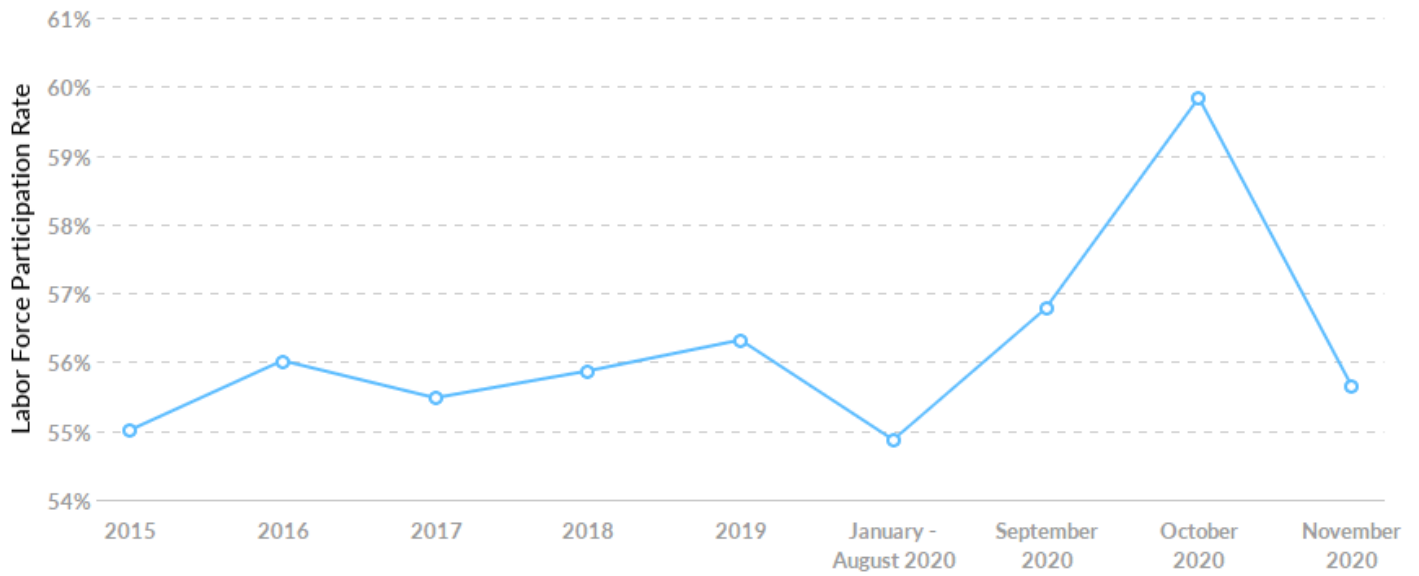
Job Trends

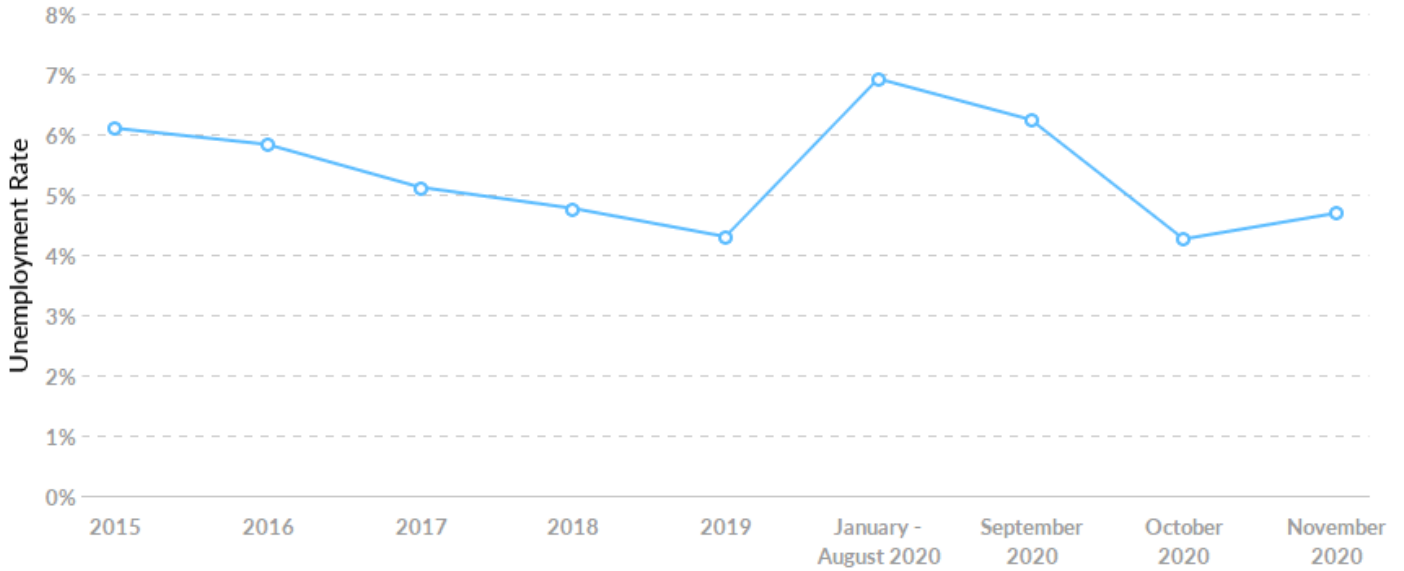

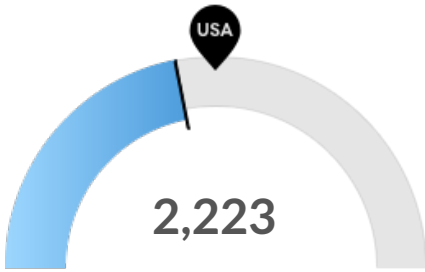
Unemployment Rate Trends

Greene County, IL had a November 2020 unemployment rate of 4.69%, **decreasing from 6.10%** 5 years before.



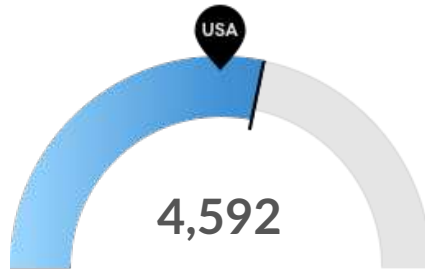

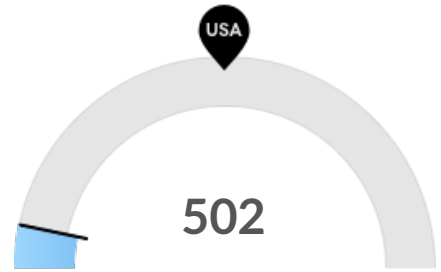
Millennials

Greene County, IL has 2,223 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 2,674.



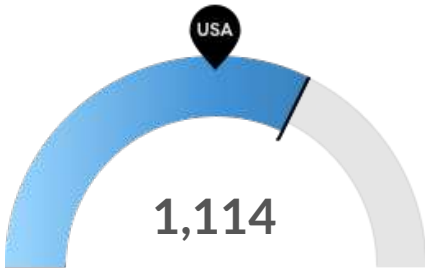
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Greene County, IL. The national average for an area this size is 3,813 people 55 or older, while there are 4,592 here.



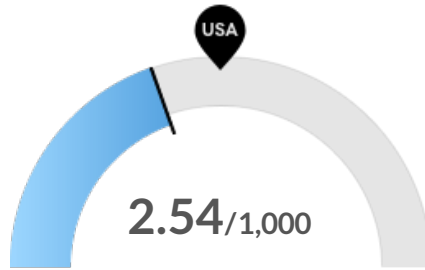
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Greene County, IL. The national average for an area this size is 5,173 racially diverse people, while there are 502 here.



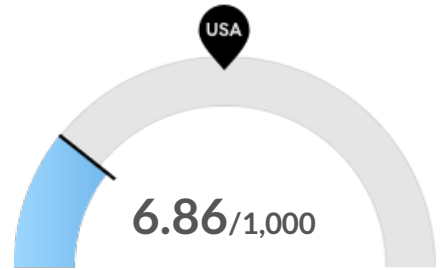
Veterans

Greene County, IL has 2.54 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

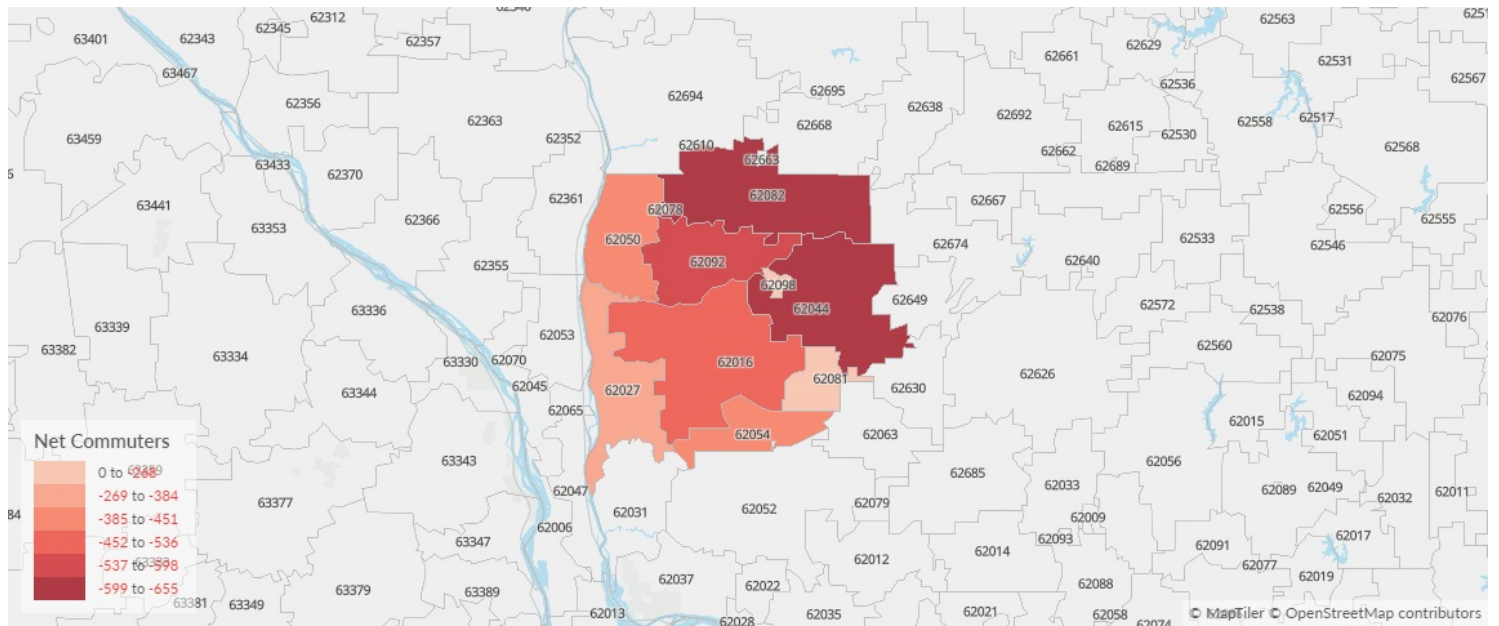


Property Crime

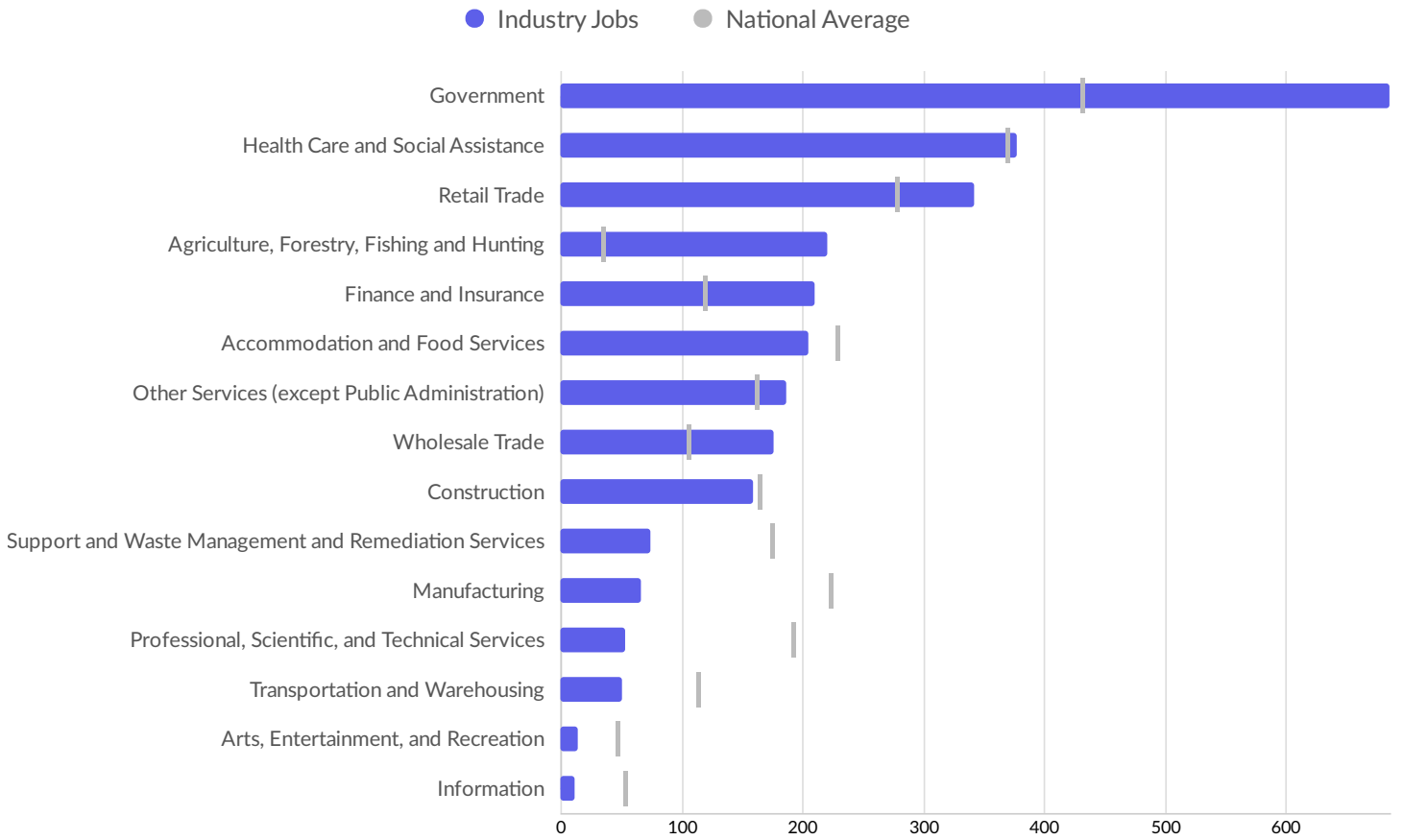

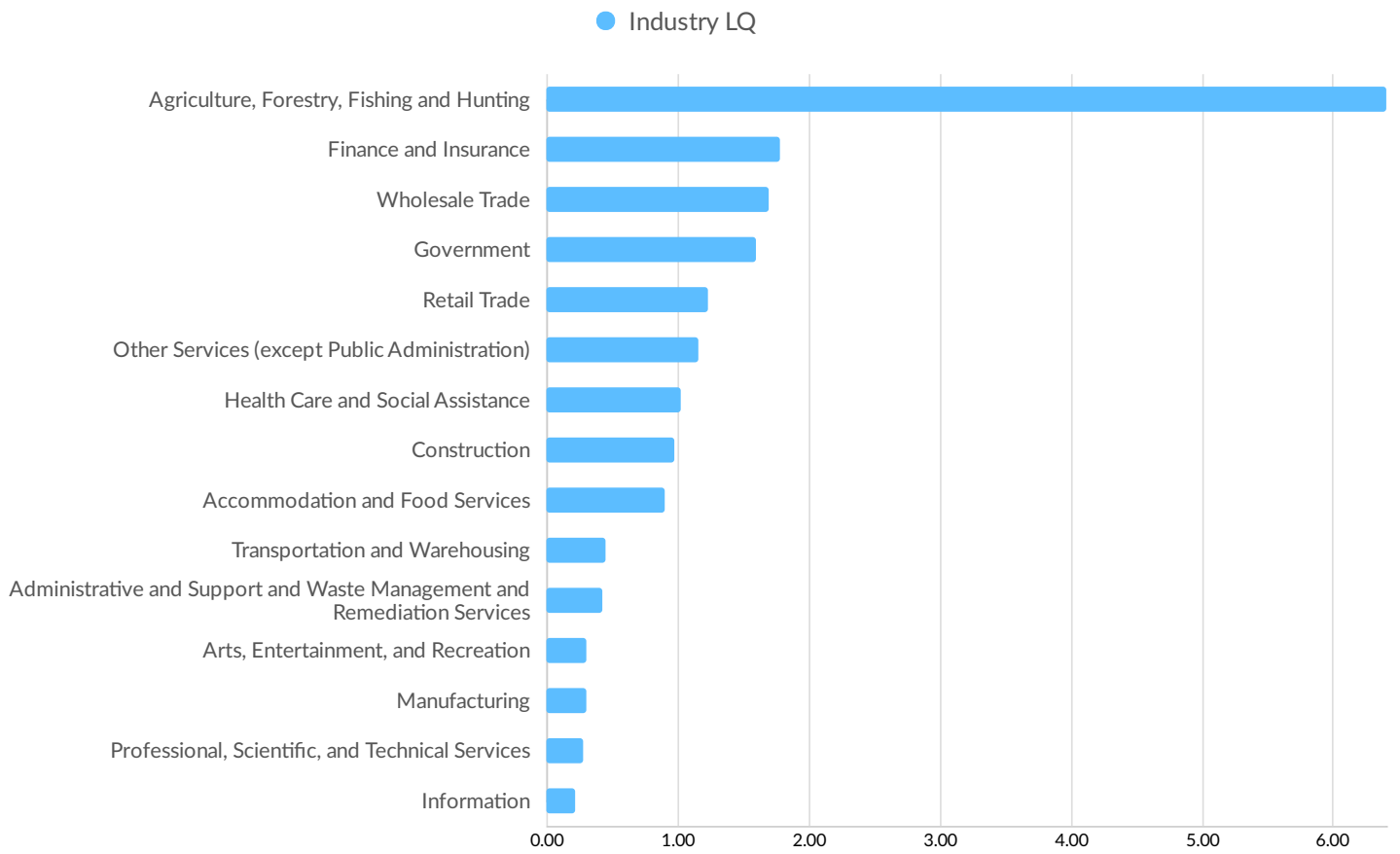

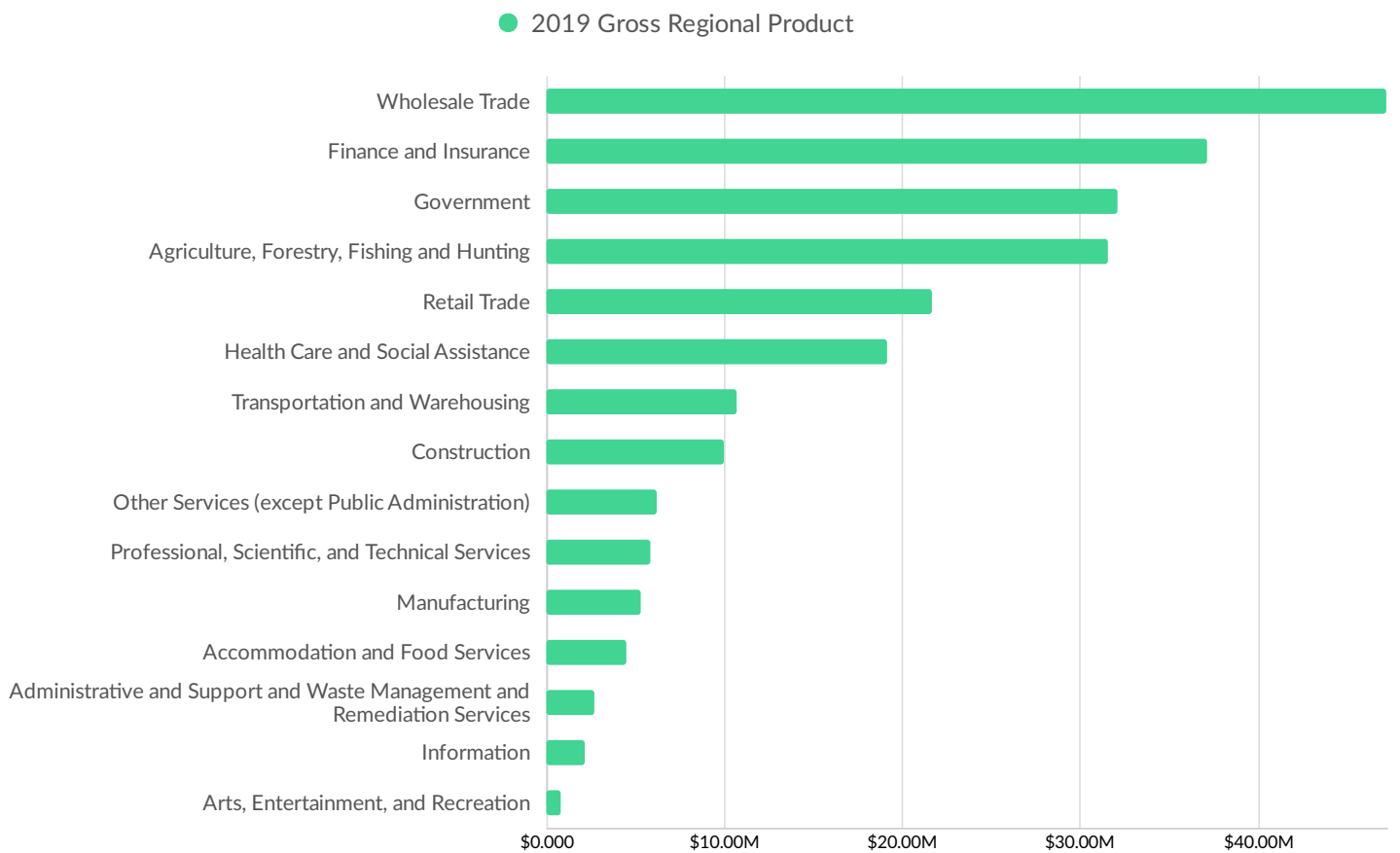
Top Growing Industries

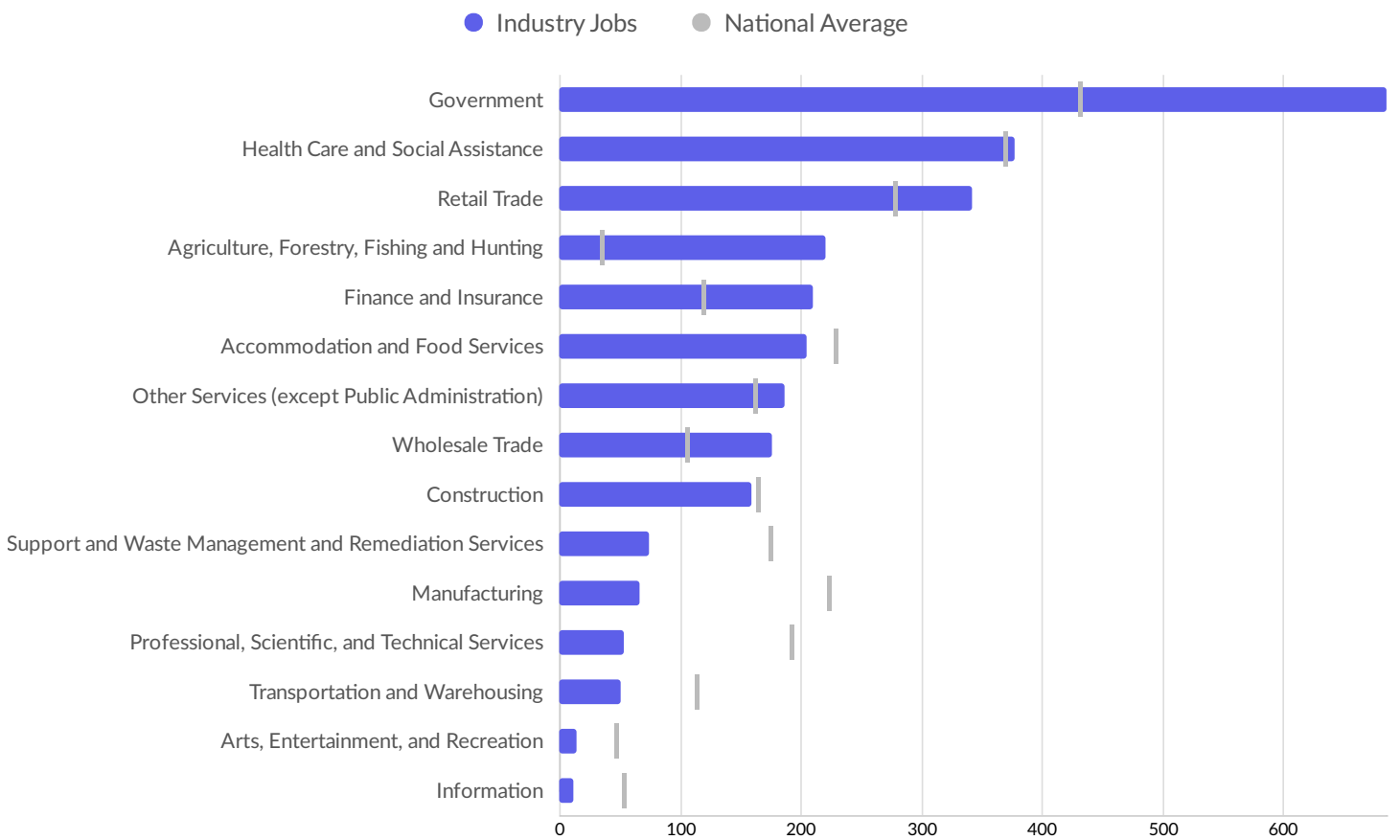

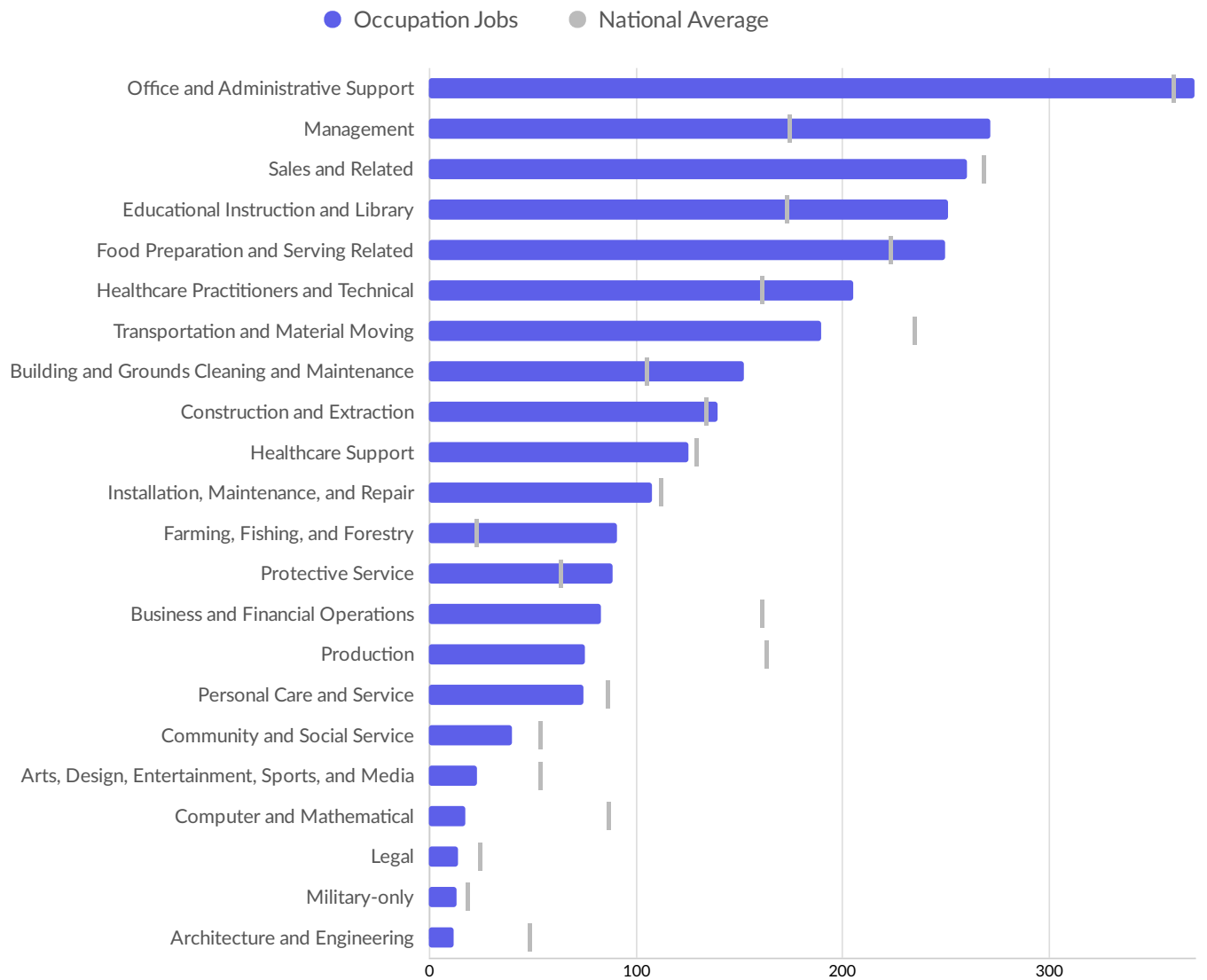

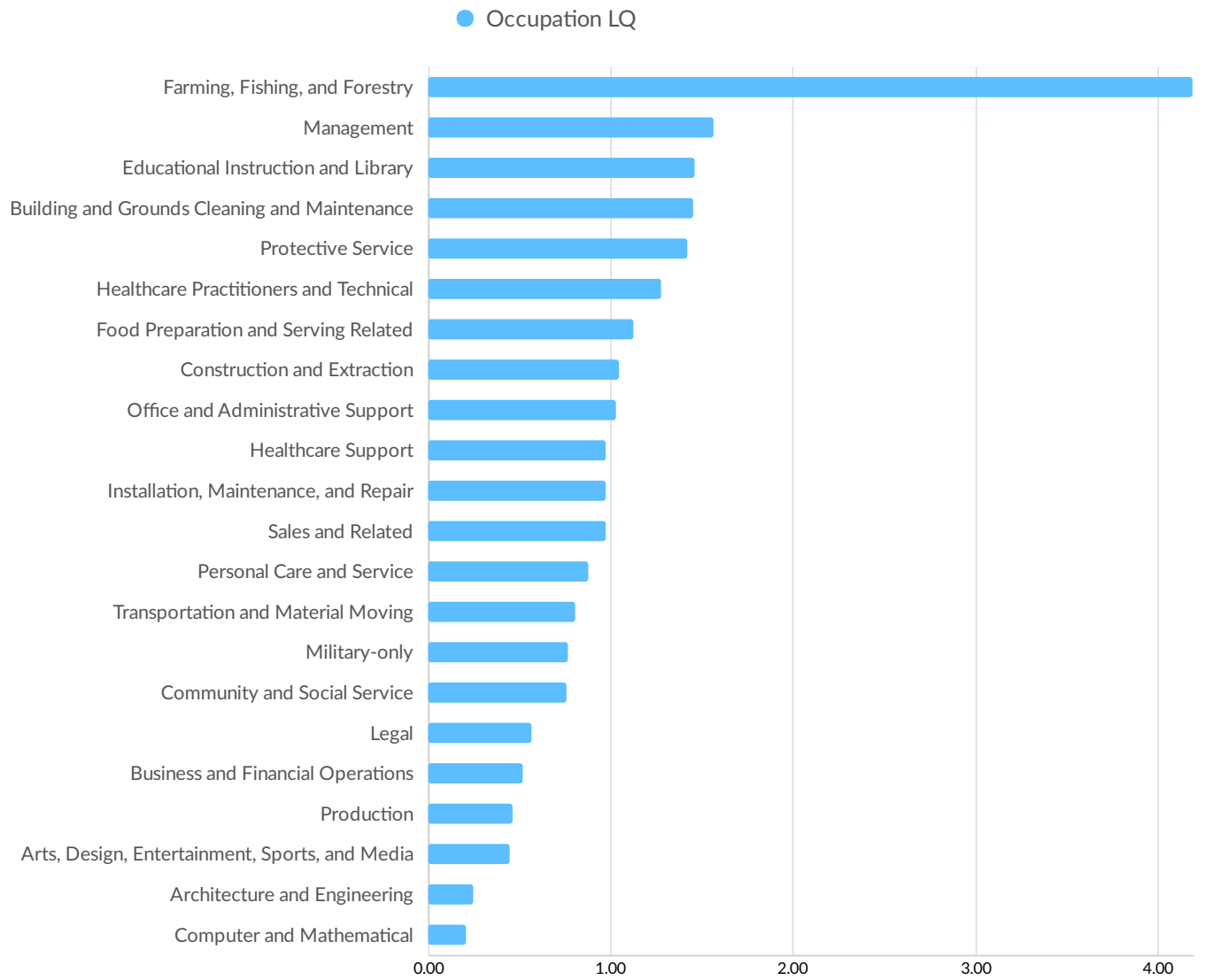

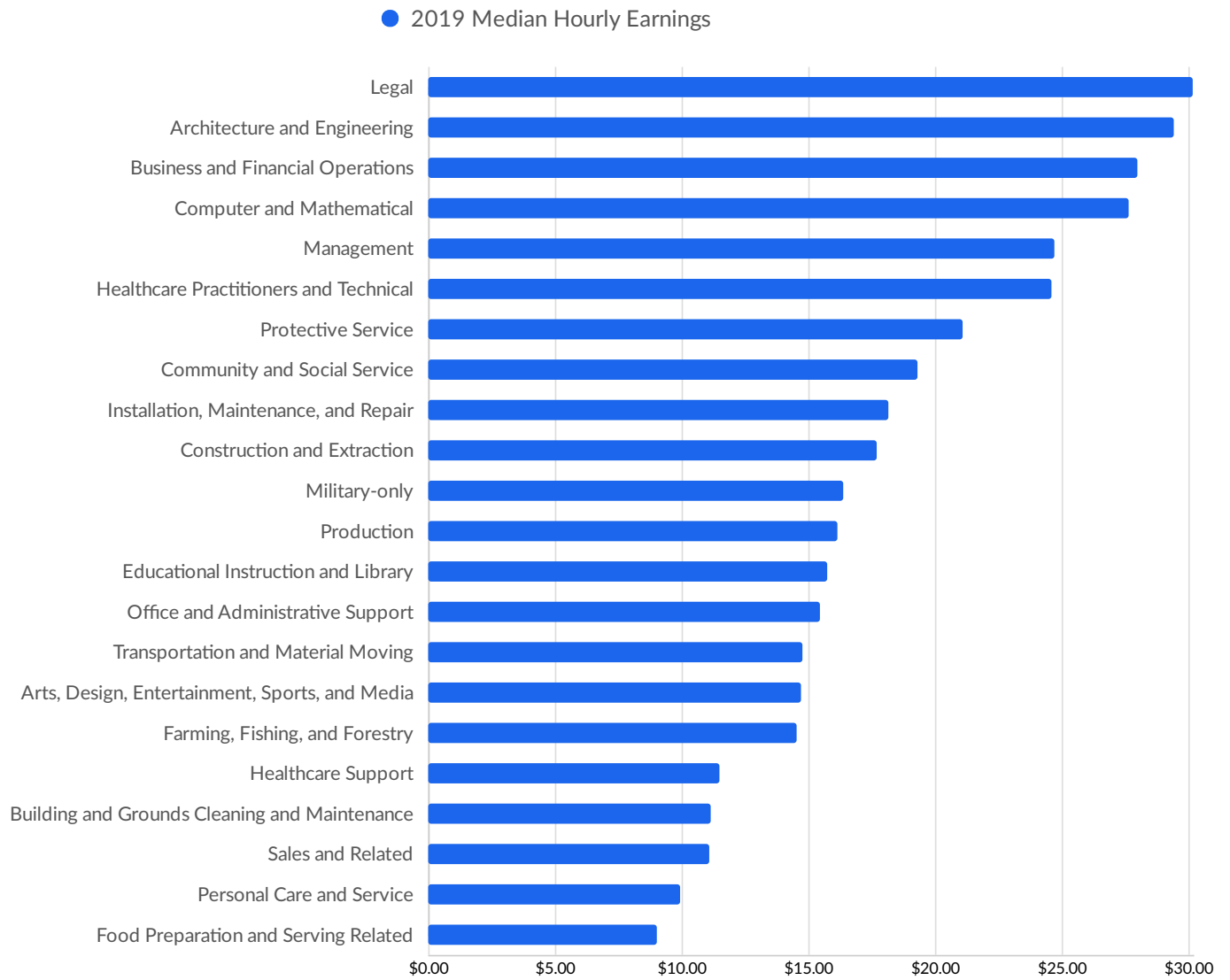

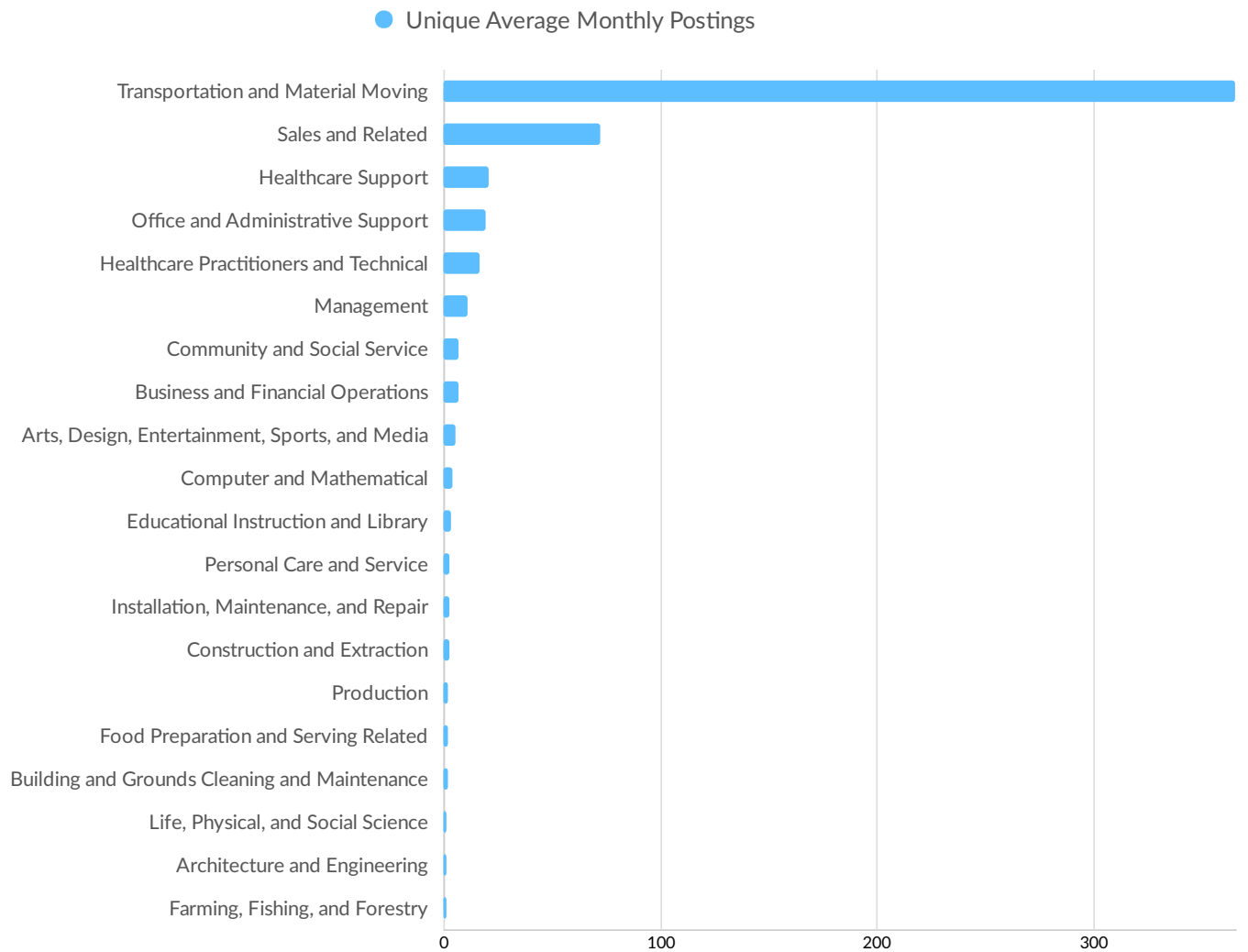

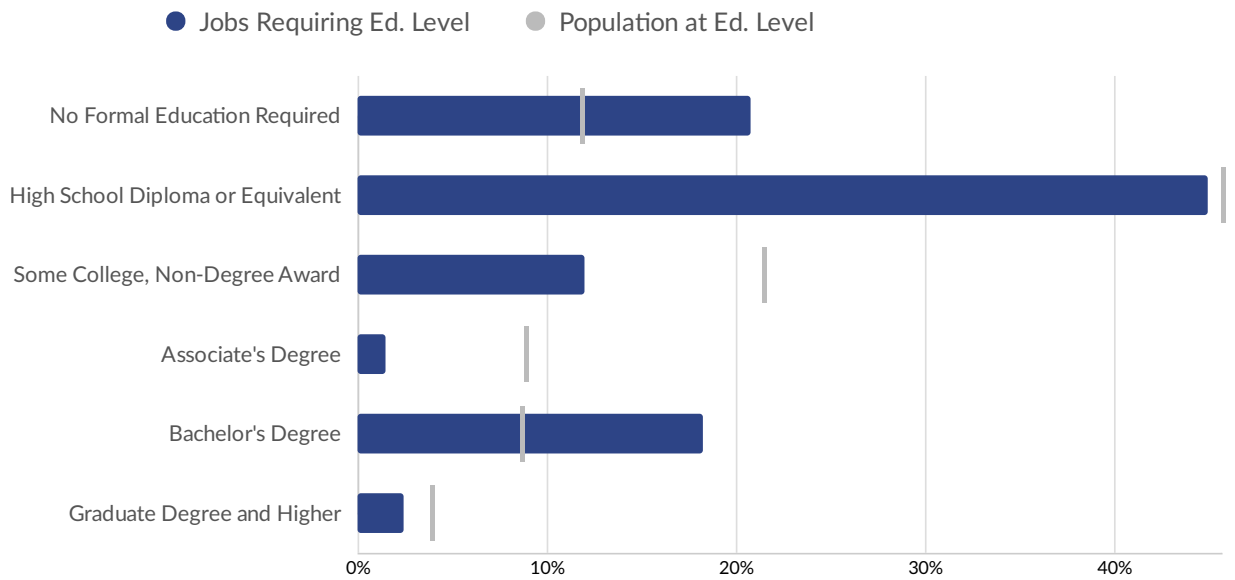

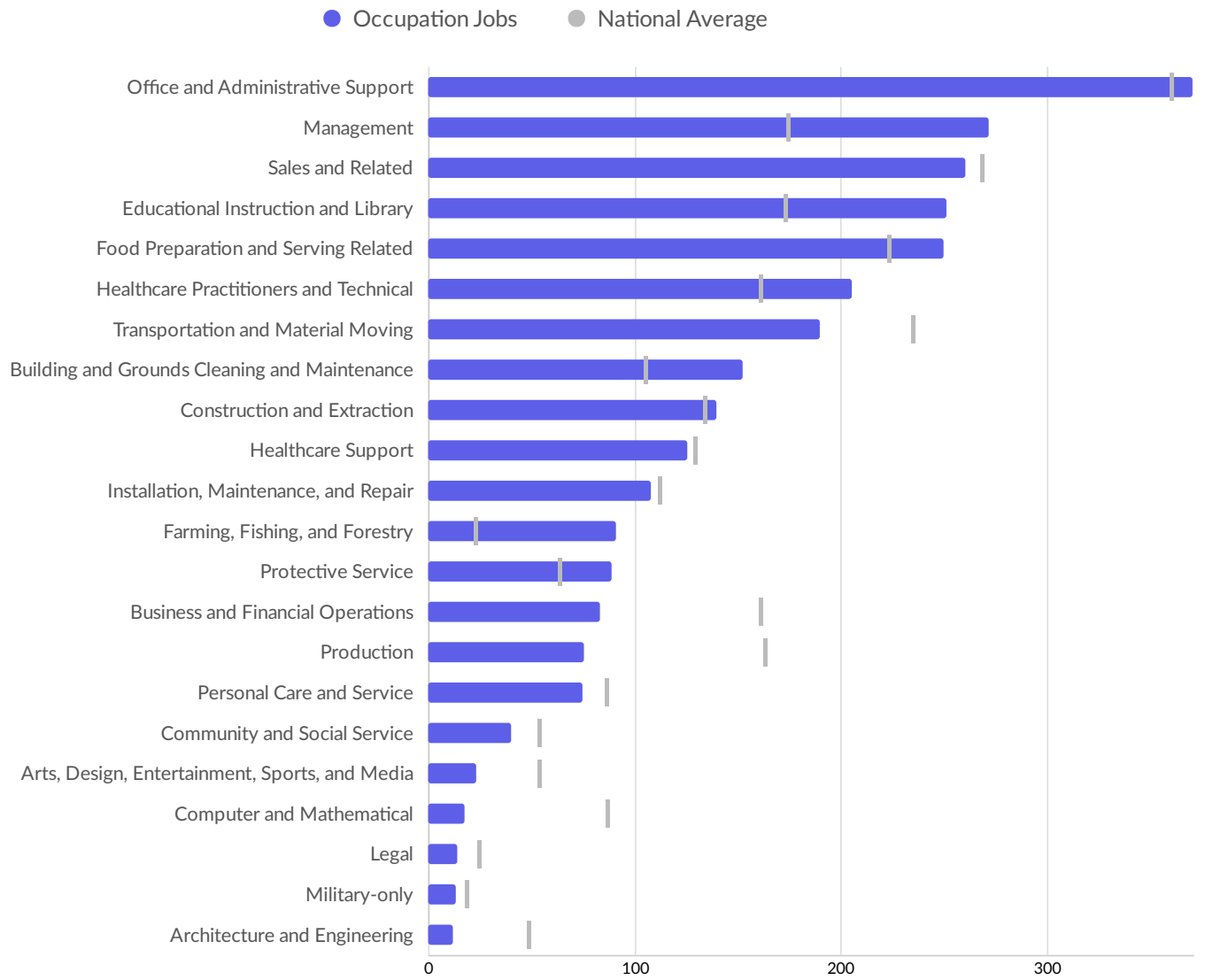
